nr. Staunton, Forest of Dean

- Car parking:** Parking along forest track. Grid Reference SO548127, post code GL16 8NZ. Sign-posted from Staunton village on A4136 Monmouth to Coleford road. Entry to forest via residential road (Wellmeadow) – please drive slowly.
- Map:** 1:10000 scale with 5m contour interval. Revised in 2017, by Pat MacLeod. Overprinted with course on waterproof paper.
- Terrain:** Mixed mature forest, steep slopes, many point features including rocks, platforms and crags. Areas of bracken and brambles.
- Courses:** White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Short Green, Green, Blue and Brown. String Course also provided. Courses suitable for beginners of all ages – help and advice available on the day.
- Registration:** Pre-entries on [Fabian4](#) by 7th January. Late entry on Fabian4 and entry on the day from 10.00 to 12.00, subject to map availability. If you are bringing a group of 15 or more, please warn the organiser two weeks in advance to ensure sufficient maps are printed.
- Start/Closure:** 10.30am – 12.30pm with queuing start. Courses close at 2.30pm.
- Entry fee:** White and Yellow courses: £3.00.
Junior and student £5 (After 7th January: £6.00);
Senior BOF members £10, Non BOF £12 (After 7th January: £12/£14)
- Punching:** SI electronic punching. Hire - Juniors free; Seniors £1.50; lost cards £30.
- Facilities:** Toilets, First Aid. Caterer selling hot food and drinks.
- Safety:** All competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety. **'No whistle, no go'** will be in force for all Juniors and recommended for Seniors.
- Dogs:** Dogs allowed on leads in car park and registration area only. Sheep, wild boar, cyclists, riders and walkers may be in the forest, so no dogs on the courses, please.
