



Bristol Orienteering Klub (BOK) Urban & Park Series

Kingswood and North Bath

- Car Parking:** Parking at Kingswood School, Bath. BA1 5RJ. ST744668. Enter via Fonthill Road
- Map:** 1:5,000, overprinted with course and descriptions on waterproof paper, size A3. Loose control descriptions will also be available. Map updated for the event by Mike Forrest.
- Terrain:** Urban, woodland and a school campus. There will be a bit of climb – this is north Bath!
- Courses:** Orange 2.0km, Green 4.2km and Blue 5.7km. Juniors (under 16) are expected to run the orange course. Juniors on all other courses must be accompanied by a responsible adult (see separate note at registration, or [download](#)). There are courses suitable for beginners of all ages; help and advice available on the day.
- Registration:** 5.30pm – 7.30pm in the activities hut at Kingswood School, next to parking.
- Start/Closure** Starts 6.00pm – 7.30pm near registration. Courses close at 8.30 pm.
- Entry Fee:** Juniors and students £3, seniors £6. Entries are available via www.fabian4.co.uk. Entries on the day will be required to complete a details form, which they can [download](#) or obtained at registration. Dibbers are available for hire: £1.50 for seniors and free for juniors and students free. Lost dibbers will be charged at £30.
- Facilities:** Portaloos available. A first aider will be in attendance. Bring your own drink.
- Safety:** Green and blue courses cross some busy roads. Courses have been planned so that these can and should be crossed at safe crossing points. The orange course crosses only minor roads within the school grounds and will be supervised. All competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety.
- Dogs:** No dogs, the assembly area is in school grounds
