Newton Park, Bath (Bath Spa University)

TRAVEL DIRECTIONS

The event will be signed from The Globe roundabout at the junction of the A4/A39 (the start of the dual carriageway section into Bath from Bristol). GR ST701653 Post Code BA29BB.

There is a 15mph speed limit throughout the campus, and lots of cameras, Beware!

PARKING

The first car park on the left, as directed by signs. This is approximately 1 mile up the drive. ST694639 BA2 9BW. **Meter parking charges of £2 will be in force.**

TERRAIN






Combination of campus, open parkland and woodland. Good training for the JK Sprint.

MAP

New map 1:4000 scale. Courses overprinted on waterproof paper.

The map has been drawn using the ISSOM 2007 sprint specification for urban areas. Additional forest symbols for ruined fence and platforms have been used. Newton Park has large areas of laurel bushes that may appear impenetrable at first sight. However there are some ways through. A non-standard symbol of dark green dots on a dull yellow background has been used to represent these laurels. Park railings have been mapped as "crossable fence", and can be crossed with care.

The following symbols for out of bounds areas and uncrossable boundaries **MUST** be obeyed.

Please be aware that there are large lakes – do not fall in! Also be aware of the possibility of falling branches from some of the mature trees.

COURSES

Yellow (1.8km), Orange (2.5km), Light Green (3.3km) and Green (4.3km). Courses suitable for beginners – help and advice available.

From 11.30am. Online entry preferred at [Fabian4](#) by preceding Thursday.

The Registration and Download will be in the car park. Entry on the day will require a completed entry form including your BOF number if known. Newcomers will find forms at registration.

ENTRY FEE

Juniors and students £3; Seniors £6.

START

12.00 am – 1.00pm with queuing start. Courses close at 2.30 pm.

The start is 25 metres across the access road, which is used by University students and staff. However, as it Easter holidays, there is unlikely to be much traffic. There will be a marshal at the car park entrance/road crossing, but please be careful.
