Meter parking charges will be in force (£2 all day fee).
- Map:** New map. Sprint specification. 1:4000 scale. Courses overprinted on waterproof paper.
- Terrain:** Combination of campus, open parkland and woodland. Good training for JK Sprint.
- Courses:** Yellow, Orange, Light Green and Green. Courses suitable for beginners – help and advice available on the day.
- Registration:** From 11.30am. Online entry preferred at [Fabian4](#) by preceding Friday. Those wishing to enter on the day are encouraged to [download](#) and complete an entry form and bring it to Registration. If you intend to bring a group of more than 15 please warn the organiser well in advance so that sufficient maps are printed.
- Start** 12.00am – 1.00pm with queuing start. The start is adjacent to car park. Courses close at 2.30 pm.
- Entry Fee:** Juniors and students £3; Seniors £6.
- Punching:** SI electronic punching. Hire - Juniors free; Seniors £1.50; lost cards £30
