



BOK Regional Event
Sunday 27th January 2019
Stockhill nr. Priddy

- Car Parking:** On forest roads within Stockhill plantations. Forest entrance at postcode BA5 3AS, grid reference ST549511. Please do not use the main public car park. Distance from parking to Registration is 0-400m.
- Map:** Remapped in 2017 by Peel Land Surveys for the 2018 British Middle Champs, with minor corrections Nov 2018 by Trevor Crowe. 1:7,5000 scale with 5m contour interval, printed on A3 landscape waterproof paper. Control descriptions will be printed on the map and also available in loose form.
- Terrain:** A working forest at 900 ft in the Mendip Hills. Tree cover is mostly coniferous and runnable, with some cleared areas. The ground features are a product of the rise and fall of lead mining, leaving many pits, depressions, rock outcrops, gullies and small hills. There are some forest roads and an irregular path network.
- Courses:** White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Short Green, Green, Blue and Brown. We hope to offer a String course but this is still to be confirmed.
- Registration:** Advance entry is **strongly recommended** [via Fabian4](#) by midnight on Sun 20th January. Late entry to midnight on Fri 25th Jan costs more and is subject to map availability. The same applies to entry on the day.
Competitors entering on the day are asked to complete an entry form. This can be downloaded [here](#) or obtained from Registration.
- Entry Fees:** £3 for everyone on White/Yellow courses, whether advance entry or EOD. Other courses are £5 for Juniors/students and £10 for adults, with a £2 supplement for adults who are not BOF members. Entry after 20th Jan or on the day is £1 extra for Juniors and £2 extra for adults.
- Start/Closure:** Queueing start from 10:30 to 12:30. Start and Finish both less than 300m from Registration. Courses close at 14:15.
- Punching:** Combined SI and SIAC ('air') electronic punching. Dibber hire free for Juniors, otherwise £1.50. Lost dibbers £40 (lost SIAC card £60).
- Facilities:** First Aid and toilets available. No traders or caterers.
- Safety:** All competitors take part at their own risk. Leg cover compulsory. Whistles compulsory for Juniors and recommended for Seniors. In the event of inclement weather, cagoules may be required. If especially serious, then event cancellation is a possibility. Pre-entered competitors will be advised by email. Others should check the BOK website 24 hours beforehand.
- Dogs:** On a lead and in the parking area only please.
