

Summary of Committee Meeting – 11th July 2013

- **Past BOK Officers** Agreed to place a list of these on the BOK Website. Thanks to Alan Kempton for compiling the list which goes back to the formation of the Klub.
- **Citations for BOK Trophies** Agreed to place details of the ‘named’ trophies on the Website. Thanks to Neil Connelly for researching and producing the information.
- **Adam Potter – British Orienteering Young Volunteer of the Year** Many congratulations from everyone in BOK for Adam’s well deserved achievement in winning this newly introduced National Award.
- **Harvester Relays** Many congratulations to the BOK Ladies team who won the ‘Panasonic Trophy’ awarded to the overall winning Womens team at the recent event. Members of the team were Alice Bedwell, Jackie Hallett, Erinna Foley-Fisher, Laura Britton and Hanne Kinnunen.
- **Mapping** Agreed to approach the National Trust to enquire if grant aid might be available to update the Leigh Woods map. BOK is developing a close and productive working relationship with the National Trust locally, most obviously at Tyntesfield but also at Dyrham Park, Stourhead and Leigh Woods.
- **Yvette Baker Trophy Final** Well done to the BOK team of just 13 juniors who performed exceptionally well to finish in 3rd place behind much larger squads.
- **Peter Palmer Junior Relays** Agreed to pay the entry fees. There is an unfortunate clash with our BOK Blast weekend.
- **Urban / Park Series** An unqualified success with attendances of generally between 60 and 80, and a number of members taking on mapping and organising for the first time. On behalf of all members the Committee would like to thank all those who organised and planned events, and in particular Mike Forrest for coming up with the idea of an integrated series and for co-ordinating it so effectively. Mike has indicated that he is willing to carry on in 2014, for which the Committee is most grateful.
- **Entry fees for the 2013/14 Season** Treasurer Patti Rudling led a detailed discussion to agree a recommendation to put before members at the 2013 AGM. Fees have been pegged since 2008/09 and with changes to the levy system, flagged at the 2012 AGM, plus increases in other event costs, a modest increase will be proposed.
- **Student Entry Fees** Confirmed the longstanding BOK practice that full time M/W21 students will pay entry fees at the Junior Rate.
- **CompassSport Cup Final** Organiser Mark Dyer reported that preparations for this Event on the 20th October are going well. Klub members face a challenge in ensuring that the event runs efficiently in the BOK tradition, while at the same time making every effort to win the Cup. It will therefore be necessary to balance start times with helper duties, and the Committee would ask for full support from all Klub members.
