Car Parking: East end of Hackett Place, outside **The Mead Primary School, BA14 7GN** (ST874585). Turn south off the A361 into Leap Gate and then first left towards the shops and pub. Registration and download are in the car park.

Map: 1:5,000 scale with 5m contours. Drawn by Richard Hudson in 2021. Waterproof size A3/A4 with courses overprinted. Loose control descriptions will also be available. Newcomers are advised to familiarise themselves with uncrossable features and out of bounds symbols. (if in doubt ask at Assembly)

Terrain: Urban footpaths, residential streets and Parkland. Road shoes recommended.

Courses: Short (Orange standard) 2.5km, Medium (Green standard) 3.8 km, Long (Blue standard) 6.0 km (distances as straight line). The short course is suitable for Juniors (under 16) to run alone as it is on quiet residential streets or parkland. On other courses Juniors must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

Registration: Pre-entry only will be via www.fabian4.co.uk - there will be no entry on the day. **The closing date for entries will be Wednesday 14th July.** Please ensure that your contact details are up to date (for Track and Trace). Your entry will be conditional on conforming to extant BOF COVID-19 guidelines available at: https://www.britishorienteering.org.uk/COVID19_Safe_orienteering

Start/Closure Starts 5.30pm – 7.30 pm. Courses close at 8.30 pm. Start and finish are on the playing field between the main car parking and Budgens. Please comply as closely as you can with your allocated Start time (as per Fabian) but we will start you as you arrive.

Entry Fee: Juniors and students £3, Seniors £6
Dibbers available for hire – both standard SI and SIAC. £1.50 for seniors; free for juniors and students. Lost dibbers charged at £30 (£50 for SIAC).

Punching: SI and SIAC (contactless) electronic punching.

Facilities: No toilets or facilities. Please bring your own drink for hydration. A first aider will be in attendance.

Safety: Please wear reflective or light coloured clothing as Trowbridge's drivers are not used to urban orienteering! Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety. If traveling alone or with relevant pre-existing medical conditions may wish to notify organiser.

Dogs: Allowed on the courses and assembly areas. On a lead or under control please.
