Winscombe and Sidcot

Event Details updated 24th April

We are grateful to Sidcot School and to Winscombe & Sandford Parish Council for kindly providing parking, access and permission to run this event

- Car parking:** Sidcot School all-weather pitch parking off The Lynch, Winscombe (**NOT located at Sidcot School**). Grid ref ST422573. What3Words: [enormous.stylists.rankings](#) Nearest postcode BS25 1LR (unreliable!). Turn onto The Lynch from the A371 in Winscombe village (look for O-sign). After 150m, The Lynch bends right, but turn left and *immediately left again*, signed "Sidcot all-weather pitch and parking".
- Map:** Updated 2021 by Trevor Crowe, drawn to ISSprOM2019, 1:4,000 with 5m contours, full legend, printed on A3 waterproof paper with courses and control descriptions overprinted. Descriptions will be 'textual' for the Short course and 'symbolic' for the Medium and Long courses. Loose descriptions will be provided at the Start.
- Terrain:** Urban footpaths, residential streets, open fields, school campus. Shorts & trainers suitable.
- Courses:** Short (2.8 km), Medium (3.6 km) and Long (5.9 km). The Short course is suitable for beginners and for sensible Juniors. It includes residential roads with pavements and one crossing of a busy road that will be marshalled for Juniors (but not for adults). Juniors (U-16) may run alone on Short, but on Medium or Long must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Registration:** **Pre-entry only** via [Fabian4](#). **Closing date is Wednesday 5th May**. No entry on the day. Please ensure that your contact details are up to date (for track & trace). Start times will be allocated to control flow. Please comply with your allocated start time to avoid bunching. Participation is conditional on conforming to the [BOF COVID-19 guidelines](#).
- Entry fee:** Juniors and students £3. Seniors £6
- Punching:** SI and SIAC (contactless) electronic punching. Dibbers available for hire through Fabian4. £1.50 for seniors; free for juniors and students. Lost dibbers charged at £37 (£62 for SIAC).
- Start/Closure:** Starts 17:30-19:30. Courses close at 20:30. The Start is a 600 m (7-8 min) walk from parking and requires crossing the busy A38 at a pelican crossing. Please cross only on a green pedestrian light. The Finish is 2 mins from the car park.
- Facilities:** A first aider will be in attendance. There are **no toilets**. There are public toilets in Winscombe village (by the old railway bridge at BS25 1AQ, grid ref ST419576 - parking adjacent).
- Safety:** **The A38 is marked uncrossable and must only be crossed using the footbridge clearly shown on the course maps.** The Medium and Long courses will also cross the A371 in Winscombe, which can be busy, with pinch points and parked cars. Juniors on the Short course will be helped to cross one busy road. All competitors take part at their own risk. Please be respectful to other pedestrians. There may be football matches underway near the car park - steer clear of players and spectators.
- Dogs:** Sorry, dogs are not allowed due to restrictions on the school campus.
